"EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULEBOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH."

Hunter sections may be run as back-to-back classes at management's discretion. When classes are run back-to-back, exhibitors may perform both rounds before leaving the ring.

Courses will simulate fences found in the hunting field such as: brush, wall, in and out, oxer, post and rails, gate, panels.

All classes will be judged on performance and soundness unless otherwise noted. Horses will not be jogged for soundness unless otherwise noted. Judges will reflect any unsoundness in their scores.

All Hunter Championships Classes: Awarded to the top two of the top four horses/ponies, which have earned the most points in over fences classes. In addition to these points, only these top four horses/ponies will receive full points for ribbons won in the under saddle class. In addition, Half points will be earned in the Regular Conformation Model class and the Green Conformation Model class, and the Small, Medium, Large & Green Pony Model classes.

Jumping Order: Jumping order will be established in accordance with the USEF rules.

HU101 - All horses competing in Federation licensed and/or USHJA sanctioned competitions with Hunter, Hunter Breeding, Jumper and Hunter/Jumping Seat Equitation classes not restricted by breed must be properly identified in accordance with GR1101, and must also be registered with USHJA (see GR1101.1). The USEF/USHJA registration number for each horse must be entered on all entry forms for licensed competitions.

Applications for USHJA Registration can be completed online at www.ushja.org or www.usef.org using the USEF Horse Registration application form. This form is also available from the USHJA or Federation office, as a download from the USHJA or Federation website or from competition management. Competition management is responsible for notifying exhibitors of this requirement in their prize list.

In addition to the provisions of HU 101.1, on or after December 1, 2017, all horses competing in classes that require USHJA horse registration must provide a microchip number that verifies their animal's identity in order to compete for points, money won or be eligible for Federation and/or USHJA programs and awards where horses are required to be recorded or registered.

A microchip used to verify identity must be a fifteen digit ISO compliant 11784/11785 chip and be implanted in the nuchal ligament of the animal.

- C. Exception: Foreign residents and horses and ponies in good standing with their National Federation are eligible to compete in this class.
- D. USHJA Zone HOTY bonus points will only be awarded if the owner is a current Active member of USEF and USHJA and the horse is recorded with USEF and registered with USHJA.
- E. Money won will only count for any USHJA National Hunter Derby standings or awards if the rider, owner and trainer are current Active members of USEF and USHJA, and the horse is registered with USHJA.
- F. The number of horses a rider can compete in a National Hunter Derby may be limited if so specified in the prize list.
- G. The prize list may specify that in order to be eligible to compete in a National Hunter Derby, a horse must compete in one or two classes at the same competition.
- H. The same horse may not compete in the USHJA National Hunter Derby and the USHJA International Hunter Derby at the same competition.
- I. Competing in the USHJA National Hunter Derby does not qualify a horse or rider for the USHJA International Hunter Derby Championship.
- J. Horses entered in this class will NOT be required to jog for soundness. Any unsoundness during the competition will be reflected in the scores from the judges (GR 1034.7).
- K. Attire: Refer to HU125 in the USEF Rule Book for current specifications.

Schooling

During the two rounds of the National Hunter Derby, all horses entered must be ridden in official horse show schooling areas unless Management designates a specific schooling area for National Hunter Derby horses. Riders must wear their horse's Derby competition number while mounted. This includes horses entered simultaneously in another class, if any. Entered horses ridden or schooled elsewhere on the competition grounds or NOT wearing their Derby competition number will be eliminated from competing in the Derby and the entry fee will be forfeited.

Order of Go

The order of go will be posted a minimum of one hour prior to the start of the class. The draw may be performed by hand or competition Management may host a computer draw. In the case of multiple horses being ridden by the same rider, every effort will be made so that there will be a minimum of eight horses (if available) separating multiple rides. All horses must be ridden in the sequence that appears on the jumping order in the first round of the competition. In the second round horses will return in reverse order of their first round scores (lowest to highest). Due to multiple rides or rider conflicts, any rider may elect to move up in the order. Should a jump-off occur, horses will return in the same order in which they competed in the second round.

Course Requirements

- A. The course diagrams for each round must be posted a minimum of one hour before the start of the first round, unless the second round is held at another time. In that case, the course for the second round must be posted a minimum of one hour prior.
- B. Dotted lines are prohibited in both the first and second rounds of any National Hunter Derby.
- C. Jumps in ALL Rounds: 1. Obstacles must simulate those reminiscent of the hunt field and course must offer a variety of Classic jumps with different appearances such as: natural post and rail, stone wall, white board fence or gate, coop, aiken, hedge, oxer, brush, logs, natural foliage. 2. Natural obstacles such as banks and ditches are allowed. 3. A minimum of 2" difference is required for the back element of all oxers. 4. Ground lines are not to exceed 18" in depth from the vertical plane of the jump. For appropriate jumps, no ground line is necessary. 5. The jumpable portion of any fence must be a minimum of 8 feet on its front face. 6. Flat cups may only be used for log fences and in accordance with Federation rules. 7. Distances will not be adjusted for ponies. 8. Fence height 3'0". 9. There must be four option fences set at 3'5".

Classic Hunter Style Course(First Round)

1. A minimum of ten obstacles must be offered in the Classic Hunter Round; 2. At least one in and out; 3. At least one bending line; 4. At least one line with an unrelated distance; 5. At least one long approach

1. Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.
2. **LIFE, SENIOR ACTIVE AND JUNIOR ACTIVE MEMBERS SHALL BE ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN ALL CLASSES AT REGULAR COMPETITIONS, EVENTING COMPETITIONS AT THE PRELIMINARY LEVEL OR ABOVE AND COMBINED DRIVING COMPETITIONS AT THE ADVANCED LEVEL, DRESSAGE, REINING AND VAULTING COMPETITIONS AND ENDURANCE RIDES. A NON-MEMBER MAY PARTICIPATE AS A HANDLER, RIDER, DRIVER, OWNER, LESSEE, AGENT, COACH OR TRAINER AT REGULAR COMPETITIONS, EVENTING COMPETITIONS, DRESSAGE COMPETITIONS, REINING COMPETITIONS AND COMBINED DRIVING COMPETITIONS UPON PAYMENT OF A \$45 SHOW PASS FEE. PARTICIPANTS IN THE FOLLOWING CLASSES ARE EXEMPTED FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS RULE: 1) LEADLINE; 2) EXHIBITIONS; 3) GAMES AND RACES; 4) CLASSES FOR 4-H MEMBERS; 5) WALK TROT (EXCEPTION: FRIESIAN PERFORMANCE FR218) AND ACADEMY CLASSES (ACADEMY CLASSES ARE CLASSES LIMITED TO HORSES USED REGULARLY IN A LESSON PROGRAM); 6) USDF INTRODUCTORY LEVEL TESTS, PAS DE DEUX AND QUADRILLE CLASSES; 7) NRHA ENDORSED REINING COMPETITIONS. 8) OPPORTUNITY CLASSES, 9) CITIZENS OF OTHER NATIONS WHO HAVE PROOF, IN ENGLISH, OF CURRENT MEMBERSHIP IN GOOD STANDING OF THEIR OWN NATIONAL FEDERATION, 10) USEA BEGINNER NOVICE DIVISION; AND 11) ASSISTANT HANDLERS IN DRESSAGE SPORT HORSE BREEDING CLASSES. EFFECTIVE 12/1/17**
3. Date of Entries: ENTRIES DUE: May 1. Post Entries will be accepted and all entries received at the horse show will receive a \$20 LATE FEE. It is recommended that entries be made **online at www.horshowsonline.com**.

4. Acceptance of Entries: Once a horse is entered and accepted by the show it may not be withdrawn from competition without the permission of management. Exhibitors shall be held responsible for the stabling fee and service fee of all horse entered by them or their authorized agents(s) even though payment of these fees is not submitted with the entry form. In any case, horses that have not shown in classes on which they have been entered shall forfeit their fees except if a horse becomes ill or is injured prior to the start of the class or classes entered. The entry fee in this case will be dropped, upon receipt of a certificate signed by a licensed veterinarian and presented to the show secretary prior to the start of the class or classes entered. Once the show has started, only certificates signed by the Show Veterinarian will be accepted.
The Horse Show Management reserves to itself the right to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify any riders or exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of entries, and cancel award prizes, without claim for damages; to change any course, to cancel or combine any classes, or to reschedule classes after due notice to exhibitors; to change rings or rotate judges; use dotted line; and to change the specifications in jumper classes as competition warrants.
5. CFHJA MEMBERSHIP: Points will be recorded for Hunter, Jumper and Equitation classes entered by CFHJA members who are permanent residents of the state of Florida and for horses/ponies that are permanently stabled in the state of Florida. Permanent resident/horse/pony CFHJA members of the state of Florida will be eligible for CFHJA year end awards. Points will start accruing the date membership payment and membership form is received.
Dues: Senior or Junior \$40/Annual. Senior or Junior/\$200 Life.
6. Required Signatures on Entry Form: Entry forms will be accepted only when signed by every exhibitor, rider, coach, agent, and trainer. If the rider or owner is a minor, the signature of the parent, guardian or trainer must be provided. Upon failure to sign an entry blank as required, such person (s) shall be subject to an automatic fine of \$250. (GR 908) Entry forms must be accompanied by a check for stall fee. No acknowledgement will be mailed.
7. Spectator admission per person is \$3.00 (including .20 sales taxes). All exhibitors, their families, trainers and grooms are exempt. Please pay at the show office.
8. STABLING: - The cost per boarding stall or tack boarding stall is \$185.00. Post entry fee AFTER MAY 1 is \$200. 471 Permanent boarding stalls with doors will be provided. Boarding Stalls are cement 12' by 12' – no initial shavings will be provided- Management reserves the right to limit tack boarding stalls. STALL CHECKS MUST ACCOMPANY STALL RESERVATIONS. Initial bedding will not be provided, and will be available through the fairgrounds. Move in date is Wednesday early arrivals will be charged \$22.00/day.
9. Prize Money: Prize money will be credited back towards each exhibitor's account. All refunds will be paid within 30 days off the close off the competition. IRS 1099 Miscellaneous Income Forms will be issued to the 1099 designee listed on the entry form. REFUNDS UNDER \$20 WILL BE CREDITED TO YOUR NEXT SHOW BILL. Prize money will be paid within 30 days of the last day of the show.
10. Show Office Hours: The Show Office will be open beginning one hour before the start of each show day and will close one half hour after the last class. Exhibitor accounts will be processed and numbers given out in the show office on WEDNESDAY.
11. Back Numbers: Numbers will be issued only when entries have been paid or an open check has been left, and when all necessary signatures, addresses, Social Security Information for Prize Money, USEF measurement, amateur, and membership cards have been presented for all riders; trainers and owners on entry.

12. a) Presentation of Federation Membership Cards: All owners, senior, junior, amateur, adult amateur riders and trainers are required to present the actual or a copy of their Federation membership card to the Show secretary. Failure to present a card will result in a \$45 per USEF and \$30 per USHJA fee (\$75.00 total) charged by USEF show pass fees. Junior and pony hunters must present the actual or a copy of their measurement cards at the Show Office before numbers may be picked up. All ponies and hunter hunters that do not possess a current measurement card will be measured. All non-members will be charged a show pass fee by USEF. Time and place of measurement stations will be announced.

b) EQ103 Eligibility to Compete

1. In order to compete in any Hunter/Jumping Seat Equitation classes at licensed competitions as an exhibitor, rider, trainer, or his/her agent(s), a person must be an Active member of the United States Hunter Jumper Association, Inc., or pay a Show Pass fee to the United States Hunter Jumper Association, Inc. Exception: Local Competitions and exceptions listed in GR901.9. Exception: Breed restricted Hunter/Jumping Seat Equitation classes.

2. USHJA Horse Registrations. a. All horses competing in Federation licensed and/or USHJA sanctioned competitions with Hunter, Hunter Breeding, Jumper and Hunter/Jumping Seat Equitation classes not restricted by breed must be properly identified in accordance with GR1101, and must also be registered with USHJA (See GR1101.1). The USEF/USHJA registration number for each horse must be entered on all entry forms for licensed competitions. b. Applications for USHJA Registration can be completed online at ushja.org or usef.org using the USEF Horse Registration application form. This form is also available from the USHJA or Federation office, as a download from the USHJA or Federation website or from competition management. Competition management is responsible for notifying exhibitors of this requirement in their prize list.

3.1 In addition to the provisions of EQ103.2, on or after December 1, 2017, all horses competing in classes that require USHJA horse registration **must provide a microchip number** that verifies their animal's identity in order to compete for points, money won or be eligible for Federation and/or USHJA programs and awards where horses are required to be recorded or registered.

3.2 A microchip used to verify identity must be a fifteen digit ISO compliant 11784/11785 chip and be implanted in the nuchal ligament of the animal.

13. Management reserves the right to limit the Courtesy Circle in Hunter and Equitation classes.

14. Horses competing without a number or with an incorrect number may be refused an award at Management's discretion.

15. Horses will be allowed in the show rings only at such hours as are announced by Management.

16. The Open Numerical Hunter Scoring System will be used at the discretion of Management.

17. Orders of Go are produced in accordance with USEF Rules. Riders and trainers who have conflicts due to classes in more than one ring at the same time should see the Paddock Master so that necessary adjustments can be made. At no time will any ring be held up over 3 minutes due to conflicts.

18. All dogs must be leashed at all times while on the show grounds. Loose dogs will be picked up and detained until the owner has paid a \$100 fine. For a second offense, the owner may be barred from showing and required to leave the show grounds. We find this extreme action necessary in order to protect our exhibitors and their horses from injury.

19. Parking will be permitted in designated parking areas only. Vehicles may be brought to the stabling areas for only the purpose of loading and unloading and then must be promptly moved to the Van Parking Area. Your cooperation is appreciated.

20. All entries are required to have a stall per Florida State Fairgrounds and Fair Authority regulations.

21. In accordance with the 1989 Federal Waste Tracking Act, which restricts the disposal of medical waste, Bio Hazardous Medical Waste Containers will be provided in the stable area. All exhibitors and their agents are responsible for the proper disposal of the waste.

22. An office fee of 10% or \$25 (which ever is greater) will be charged on all returned checks.

23. All horses entering the state of Florida must possess an official interstate health certificate issued by a licensed veterinarian attesting to the fact that the animals are free from any symptom of infections or communicable disease. Current negative Coggins Test must be available upon demand.

24. **ADDS/ SCRATCHES:** All adds and scratches must be completed through the Show Office **AND TAKEN TO THE RING BEFORE THE ADDED OR SCRATCHED CLASS BEGINS.**

25. All exhibitors are required to wear properly fitting protective headgear when jumping on the show grounds. Additionally, all riders (including adults) in hunter, hunt seat equitation and jumper classes is required and while jumping on competition grounds must wear ASTM/SEI approved helmets. See GR 801.2 for further details.

26. Central Florida Hunter Jumper Association, Inc., The Bob Thomas Equestrian Center, their officials and employees will not be responsible for any accident or loss which may occur to any exhibitor, spectators, guest, rider, groom, attendant or other employee, animal or equipment at any of the shows.

27. Should any question arise that is not provided for in the rules, the same shall be referred to the show committee whose decision shall be final.

28. Trophies: In classes not offering prize money, trophies will be awarded in the show office.

29. By signing the entry form, exhibitors acknowledge and understand the following warning as provided in Florida Senate Bill 1658, Chapter 773, "Equine Zero Liability Statute": **WARNING – Under Florida law, an Equine Activity sponsor or equine professional is not liable for an injury to, or the death of, a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risk of equine activities."**

30. Tack stall splits will be accepted when all entries are received and before 3pm on Friday. If tack stalls are not split they will be billed to a barn account. All shavings and feed orders are COD in the Fairgrounds office by 6 PM on Friday.

31. **MOTORIZED VEHICLE USE RULE** – Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The Parent(s), legal guardian (s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

33. CHECK OUT - ANY MISTAKES AT CHECKOUT MUST BE RESOLVED WITHIN 24 HOURS.

34. EXPRESS CHECK OUT = FILL OUT A SELF-ADDRESSED ENVELOPE AND WE WILL SEND YOU YOUR STATEMENT.

35. Food concessions will be available during horse show hours.

36. All horses competing in Federation non-breed restricted licensed competitions with hunter, hunter breeding, jumper and hunter seat equitation classes (except those activities enumerated in GR901.9, items 1-9) must be properly identified and must obtain a Registration Number from USHJA. A registration number for each horse must be entered on all entry forms for licensed competitions. Only one Registration Number will be issued per horse, and must remain with the horse throughout its career.

37. Equine Vaccination Rule GR845

At Federation licensed competitions, horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinoepneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by Competition Management. Documentation should consist of one of the following methods mentioned below. The frequency of vaccine administration should be per the vaccine manufacturers' or veterinarian's recommendations. It is recommended that vaccines are administered by or under the direction of a veterinarian.

In the case of vaccines administered by a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide documentation from the veterinarian on documenting that the horse in question received the vaccinations; name of the vaccines and date of vaccine administration.

In the case of vaccines administered by a person other than a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide a receipt of the vaccine purchase which is signed by the owner, or agent with care, custody, and control of the horse; name, serial number and expiration date of the vaccine; and date of vaccine administration.

In the case of a horse that is unable to receive either of the vaccinations due to a history of adverse reactions, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide a letter from the veterinarian on official letterhead stating that the horse in question cannot be vaccinated due to medical concerns and a log of temperatures taken twice daily for the seven days prior to entering the competition grounds. These horses must also have their temperature taken and logged twice daily while on the competition grounds. The log of temperatures should be provided to the Competition Management, steward, or technical delegate when requested.

Competition Management may not amend or enhance vaccination requirements without prior approval of the Veterinary Committee.

- To be ridden by exhibitors who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1 of the current competition year.

ADULT AMATEUR HUNTER Sections offered and requirements:

- Adult Amateurs – may be split into three (3) sections Cross Entry: Rider: Riders in this section may enter any Equitation class and any class where otherwise eligible. Riders who compete in the Amateur Owner Hunter and/or Jumper classes may show other horses that they own in the Adult Amateur Hunters.

Horse: Horses and ponies exhibiting in this section may cross enter multiple sections of Adult Amateur Hunter and any classes where eligible.

Horse and Rider Combination: n/a

Fence height: • 3'0" or 3'3" with spreads not to exceed the fence height.

Horse: Horses and ponies exhibiting in this section may cross enter multiple sections of Adult Amateur Hunter and any classes where eligible.

Combining/Dividing Sections: May be split into three sections: • Adult Amateurs 18– 35 • Adult Amateurs 36– 49 • Adult Amateurs 50 & over

The Adult Amateur Hunter section may be divided by age of rider and/or height of fences. If there are fewer than three (3) entries in a section, that section must be combined with another. Horse and Rider Combination: Low Adult Amateur Jumper horse/rider combinations may not cross enter into any classes held above 1.15m at the same show. Low Adult Amateur Jumper horse/rider combinations may enter only one classic, if both Low and High are offered.

High Adult Amateur Jumper horse/rider combinations are not permitted to cross enter into Amateur Owner Jumper classes or any class at 1.20m and above, that offers prize money, at the same competition. High Adult Amateur Jumper horse/rider combinations may enter only one classic, if both Low and High are offered.

Riders cannot cross enter into any class where fences exceed 3'3" (exception: Riders may show in Pony Jumpers).

Performance Hunter 3'3" [HU112]

- The Performance Hunter section may be divided after 30 or more horses have competed in the first over fences class and subsequent classes may be divided once 12 horses have competed in each class
- Section must be held separately if there are six or more entries
- If there are fewer than six entries, the section must be combined with the Performance Hunter 3'6"
- If there are 50 or more entries in a section, it must be divided
- There is no requirement for the method of dividing the Performance Hunter section; classes may be split using the California split or a random split
- If there are fewer than 30 entries in the under saddle class in a section using the California split, it is not required to be split in order to award multiple section championships
- When a random split is used, multiple Championships may only be awarded if a minimum of two (2) over fences and one (1) under saddle class are held per section.

High Performance Hunter [HU112.3]

- The High Performance Hunter section may be divided once 30 or more horses have competed in the first over fences class and subsequent classes may be divided once 12 horses have competed in each class
- If there are 50 or more entries in a section it must be divided.
- If there are fewer than 3 entries, the High Performance section may be combined with either the Performance Hunter 3'6" section or Green Hunter 3'9" (or Green Hunter 3'6"/3'9" if offered combined), but it may not be combined with both.
- If the High Performance Hunter is combined with Green Hunter 3'9" and there are still fewer than 3 entries, it must be further combined with the Green Hunter 3'6".
- When combining the High Performance with the Performance Hunter 3'6" or the Green Hunter 3'9", the new combined section will use the lower amount for entry fees and prize money originally offered for each section.
- When High Performance Hunter is combined with Performance Hunter 3'6" or Green Hunter 3'9", the combined sections must offer the same number of classes.
- If there are fewer than 30 entries in the under saddle class in a section using the California split, it is not required to be split in order to award multiple section championships
- When a random split is used, multiple Championships may only be awarded if a minimum of two (2) over fences and one (1) under saddle class are held per section.

Green Hunter Sections (3', 3'3", 3'6", 3'9") [HU113]

(May not be combined with any other Hunter section)

- Premier competitions must offer all four sections separately
- National and Regional I & II competitions may offer sections separately. They may also offer combined as follows: Green Hunter/3'3" - Green Hunter/3'6"/3'9"
- Sections may not be divided if there are less than 30 entries [HU112]
- Sections must be divided if there are more than 50 entries [HU112]
- Regardless of how sections are offered, a minimum of 3 entries are required
- If there are a minimum of 3 entries in sections offered separately, the section(s) must be held separately
- When the Green Hunter section is offered combined, it must be split by fence height and held separately if there are minimum of three entries in each fence height section.
- Contiguous fence height sections should be combined before combining non-contiguous fence height sections.
- Green Hunter sections may not be combined with any other Hunter section

Young Hunter Sections (3', 3'3", 3'6") [HU114]

(May not be combined with any other Hunter section)

- Premier competitions must offer all four sections separately

- National and Regional I & II competitions may offer sections separately. They may also offer combined as follows: Young Hunter 3'3"/3' and Young Hunter 3'6" / Young Hunter 3' and Young Hunter 3'3"/3'6"
- Sections may not be divided if there are less than 30 entries [HU112]
- Sections must be divided if there are more than 50 entries [HU112]
- Regardless of how sections are offered, a minimum of 3 entries are required

- If there are a minimum of 12 entries when sections are combined, the newly combined section must be split using one of the following options so that there are at least six in the resulting sections [HU112.4]: a. By age of rider (age must be given on entry blank, 15 and under & 16-17)
- b. By height of horse
- c. Floating Split (See HU112.5 for definition of Floating Split)
- d. California Split (See HU112.6 for definition of California Split)

High Performance Conformation Hunter / Green Conformation Hunter [HU115]

- Sections may not be divided if there are less than 30 entries [HU112]
- The Green and High Performance Conformation sections must be offered separately at Premier competitions
- Sections must be combined when there are three or fewer horses in either section
- Sections must be divided if there are four or more horses in each Conformation section
- When combining the Green Conformation Hunter with the High Performance Conformation Hunter the new combined section will use the lower amount for entry fees and prize money originally offered for each section

Amateur Owner 3'6" [HU116]

- National and Premier competitions must offer two sections: A/O 18-35 (or floating split) and A/O 36+ (or floating split)
- If there are fewer than six entries in either age section, then they must be combined
- If there are at least six in each age section, then both age sections must be held separately
- If there are a minimum of 12 entries when sections are combined, the newly combined section must be re-divided using a floating or California Split (see HU112)
- If both age sections are combined and there are fewer than three (3) total [HU116.1c]:
- (1) the combined A/O 3'6" section maybe canceled at Management's discretion [HU162]; or
- (2) the combined A/O 3'6" section maybe further combined with Amateur Owner 3'3" and/or a completely combined Junior Hunter section, at Management's discretion [HU116.1c]

- National and Premier competitions must offer two sections: A/O 18-35 (or floating split) and A/O 36+ (or floating split)
- If there are fewer than six entries in either age section, then they must be combined
- If there are at least six in each section, then they must be held separately
- If there are a minimum of 12 entries when sections are combined, the newly combined section must be re-divided using a floating or California Split (see HU112)
- If both age sections are combined and there are fewer than three (3) total [HU116.1c]:
- (1) the combined A/O 3'3" section maybe canceled at Management's discretion [HU162]; or

(2) the combined A/O 3'3" section maybe further combined with Amateur Owner 3'6" and/or a completely combined Junior Hunter section, at Management's discretion [HU116.1c]

• Amateur Owner 3'3" must have both age groups combined in one section before combining with the Junior Hunter or Amateur Owner 3'6" sections. [HU116.1c]

Regular Pony Hunter [HU117]

• National and Premier competitions must offer three height sections (small, medium, large)

• Sections may be combined if there are three (3) or fewer entries in any height section

• Sections must be held separately if there are four (4) or more entries in each height section

• See HU117.4 for B and C rated sections

Green Hunter Pony [HU117]

• National and Premier competitions must offer a minimum of two sections (small/medium and large) but may offer three sections

• Sections may be combined if there are three or fewer entries in any height section

• Sections must be split into small, medium and large if there are four or more entries in any height section

• See HU117.4 for B and C rated sections
