"EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULEBOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH."

Hunter sections may be run as back-to-back classes at management's discretion. When classes are run back-to-back, exhibitors may perform both rounds before leaving the ring.

Courses will simulate fences found in the hunting field such as: brush, wall, in and out, oxer, post and rails, gate, panels.

All classes will be judged on performance and soundness unless otherwise noted. Horses will not be jogged for soundness unless otherwise noted. Judges will reflect any unsoundness in their scores.

All Hunter Championships Classes: Awarded to the top two of the top four horses/ponies, which have earned the most points in over fences classes. In addition to these points, only these top four horses/ponies will receive full points for ribbons won in the under saddle class. In addition, Half points will be earned in the Regular Conformation Model class and the Green Conformation Model class, and the Small, Medium, Large & Green Pony Model classes.

Jumping Order: Jumping order will be established in accordance with the USEF rules.

In all classes over obstacles, all horses being considered for an award must jog for soundness using either Option A or Option B below. Management must state in the competition prize list which method of jogging will be used. Horses/ponies that are unsound will be eliminated and ineligible for an award in that class. The judge's decision regarding soundness is final.

Option A: Horses/ponies are required to trot a circle on a loose rein at the end of each over fences performance. Horses/ponies may be asked to return to the ring and trot another circle at the judge's discretion.

Option B: Horses/ponies will be jogged together with the rider unmounted in the judge's order of preference. Two additional entries in addition to the number of ribbons must jog if there are sufficient entries. Horses/ponies may be asked to re-jog at the judge's discretion. A horse/pony may not leave the ring until the job has been declared official by the judge, or it will be eliminated. A horse that is unruly, one that breaks away from the handler or one whose actions threaten to endanger the rider, handler, other exhibitors or their entries will be eliminated. (Exception: Hunter Breeding and Pony Breeding). A horse may not be eliminated for receiving outside assistance in the jog. In classes restricted to ponies a junior must jog the pony for soundness

HU103 - All horses competing in Federation licensed and/or USHJA sanctioned competitions with Hunter, Hunter Breeding, Jumper and Hunter/Jumping Seat Equitation classes not restricted by breed must be properly identified in accordance with GR1101, and must also be registered with USHJA (see GR1101.1). The USEF/USHJA registration number for each horse must be entered on all entry forms for licensed competitions.

Applications for USHJA Registration can be completed online at www.ushja.org or www.usef.org using the USEF Horse Registration application form. This form is also available from the USHJA or Federation office, as a download from the USHJA or Federation website or from competition management. Competition management is responsible for notifying exhibitors of this requirement in their orize list.

In addition to the provisions of HU 101.1, on or after December 1, 2017, all horses competing in classes that require USHJA horse registration must provide a microchip number that verifies their animal's identity in order to compete for points, money won or be eligible for Federation and/or USHJA programs and awards where horses are required to be recorded or registered.

A microchip used to verify identity must be a fifteen digit ISO compliant 11784/11785 chip and be implanted in the nuchal ligament of the animal.

Eligible riders are those who have not competed in any of the following National Equitation Finals with fences at 3'6" within the same competition year including: ASPCA Maclay Finals, USEF Hunter Seat Medal Finals, USEF Show Jumping Talent Search Finals (East or West), WIHS Equitation Classic Finals, Jump Canada Medal Finals or the North American Equitation Championship. B. Once a rider has won the USHJA 3'3" Hunter Seat Medal Finals, she/he is not eligible to compete again. C. Once a rider has competed in any of the aforementioned finals they remain ineligible to compete in the 3'3" Hunter Seat Medal. Courses requirements

A. To be shown over a course of no less than eight obstacles with fence heights of 3'3" and spreads to 3'6" (exception: triple bar obstacles may have a maximum spread of 4'). B. One third of the obstacles must be oxers.

C. Courses must include at least two changes of direction after the first obstacle. D. All courses must include at least three of the following: 1. Bending Line 2. Narrow Jump (5'6"-8') 3. Roll back turn 4. Fence at the end of the ring 5. Long approach to a single jump

E. Liverpools, water jumps or water used as decoration are prohibited.

F. Testing: Two or more tests of the following number of competitors are required. In classes with three (3) who complete the course, three (3) competitors must be called back for testing. In classes with four (4) to thirty (30) who complete the course, at least the top four (4) competitors must be called back for testing. In classes with thirty-one (31) or more who complete the course, at least the top six (6) competitors must be called back for testing. Eight places must be awarded in classes with thirty-one (31) or more entries. Tests 1-17. Any exhibitor who does not participate in the testing is placed last of those exhibitors called back to test. Should more than one exhibitor fail to return for testing they will be placed at the judge's discretion. Only one rider per horse (EQ-2.111 5.B)

To fill a USHJA 3'3" Hunter Seat Medal class, a minimum of three competitors must complete the course. D. If there are forty or more entries at the beginning of a USHJA 3'3" Hunter Seat Medal class, it may be divided by every other number and run as two separate sections. E. If there are fifty or more entries at the beginning of a USHJA 3'3" Hunter Seat Medal class, it must be divided by every other number and run as two separate sections. F. Only one rider may compete per horse entered in an USHJA 3'3" Hunter Seat Medal class. Entry Fee: \$75

396 WEC EQUITATION CUP

The World Equestrian Center Premier Equitation Cup is open to junior riders who have not reached their 18th birthday on December 1st. Only one rider per horse and one horse per rider is permitted. The World Equestrian Center Premier Cup Final is during the 2024 Ocala Winter Spectacular VI Horse Show. Riders will need to place 1st - 8th in at least two qualifying classes during the 2023 show season to qualify for the championship final to be held in winter 2024.

Courses for the Equitation Class & Premier Equitation Cup Championship Qualifying Round & Final:

To be shown over a course of at least eight obstacles.

Course must include: One combination (including an oxer), At least two changes of direction after the first obstacle, At least three of the following: Bending Line, Narrow Jump (5'6"-8"), Roll back turn, 30% of the obstacles must be oxers, Obstacle height to be set at 3'6", Oxers will be a maximum width of 4', Triple bars and other specialty fences set at a maximum width of 5', Liverpool and water jumps are prohibited, Water used as decoration is permitted. Judging: To be judged on seat, hands, guidance, and control of the horse. After completion of the jumping phase a minimum of twelve riders, if available, are required to return for the flat phase. The flat phase will be judged on ider's position, seat, and correct effective use of aids. Riders will perform the working walk, the working trot sitting, and the working trot rising, as well as showing a lengthening of stride. Riders will also show the working counter canter, and the working canter showing a lengthening of stride. All riders will be required to show a working counter canter.

Conditions: Only competitions recognized by the World Equestrian Center are eligible to hold the WEC Premier Equitation Cup Class. Only one rider per horse. Only one horse per rider. A minimum of two competitors are required to complete the course. If there are more than 25 entries at the beginning of the class, it may be divided by every other number and run as two separate sections. This class may not be run using a California split. Two refusals will constitute elimination.

No more than 12 riders shall counter canter at one time. In addition, the flat phase may include, but not limited to

Shoulder-in, Shoulder-out, Haunches-in, and Haunches-out. The flat phase shall count for 40%.

The THIS NHS Adult Medal and Finals are open only to senior members of the USEF or Equine Canada who have reached their 18th birthday as of December 1st of the current competition year in accordance with GR101. Previous winners of the Finals are ineligible to compete in any THIS NHS Adult Medal or the Finals. Rider and trainer (or coach when applicable [see USEF GR108]) must be current members of the National Horse Show Association ("NHSA"). The NHSA Membership year is September 1 through August 31. Adult rider annual contributions shall be \$35. Trainer (or coach) annual contributions shall be \$50. A rider may enter any NHS Adult Medal anywhere in the United States according to the conditions published in the current Rule book of the USEF. To be judged on seat, hands, auidance and control of the horse. After completion of the jumping phase a minimum

of twelve (12) riders, if available, are required to show at a walk, trot and canter. The flat performance of those riders selected to show in the flat phase shall count 50%. USEF Tests 1-23.

Only one rider per horse. To fill a THIS NHS Medal three (3) competitors must complete the course. If there are 40 or more entries at the beginning of a THIS NHS Adult Medal, it may be divided by every other number and run as two separate sections. If there are 50 or more entries at the beginning of a THIS NHS Adult Medal, it must

be divided by every other number and run as two separate classes. Entry Fee: \$75

Trophy & Eight Ribbons

398 THE USEF/NCEA JUNIOR HUNT SEAT MEDAL 3'3"

Open to all Junior members of the USEF or Equine Canada. Riders need not be members of the NCEA Medal to compete in the class, but only riders who possess a current NCEA Medal membership number will accrue points and be put on the NCEA Medal ranking list. Riders will compete in the NCEA Medal ranking list (East Coast, Midwest, West Coast) based on their address submitted to the NCEA Medal membership office, unless at the time of application for membership they elect in writing to compete in the other coast final. Class is pinned based on combined performance over two phases, fences and flat. Competitors must use the same horse in both phases. Fences Phase: To be shown over a minimum of eight fences 3' 3" in height, spread not to exceed fence height. The course may be either a Jumper or Hunter type course and must include at least two changes of direction and a combination. Water obstacles and liverpools are not permitted. An open numerical scoring system must be used in the first phase, with each rider's score announced at the completion of their round.

Flat Phase: The top 10 will be asked to return to the arena for a flat phase performing at a walk, trot and canter. From USEF Tests 1-23. In addition, riders are required to perform 2 of 3 basic dressage movements of a shoulder-in, haunches-in or leg yield both directions of the ring at the discretion of the judge. The Under Saddle performance of those riders selected to participate in this phase shall count 50% of the overall two phase performance. There is no minimum requirement to fill the class. Riders who do not return for the flat phase are not eligible for a ribbon overall per EQ107.6

Class to be judged in accordance with current USEF standards for equitation. Conventional tack per USEF EQ106.5. Splitting of classes: Classes with greater than 50 entries must be split using the California Split. No other method of splitting is allowed.

399 EMO INSURANCE/USHJA 3'3" JUMPING SEAT MEDAL

Open to Junior Active Members of the Federation and USHJA who have not reached their 18th birthday (per USEF rules). Riders must be current Active members of USEF and USHJA prior to the start of the class (see GR202). Foreign residents who are also members of USEF and USHJA will be eligible to compete.

Any rider that has jumped 1.30m or above, competed in a USEF Show Jumping Talent Search 2* or 3* class is prohibited from competing in a USHJA 3'3" Jumping Seat Medal class within the same competition year. Riders are prohibited from competing in a USEF Show Jumping Talent Search 2* or 3* class and a USHJA 3'3" Jumping Seat Medal class at the same competition.

One (1) point will be subtracted from the rider's score for each commenced second over the time allowed and four (4) points will be deducted for each knockdown on course.

Judges are asked to walk the course when possible and where there are striding options, the judges are asked not to penalize an option that might be used to achieve the best result appropriate to the track taken and the individual horse/rider combination. JP134 (The competition round) and JP135 (Timing) will apply. No work-off is required. Two refusals will incur elimination. Blinkers are forbidden. Running martingales used in the conventional manner are permitted. Standing martingales, draw reins or restricted running martingales are prohibited. See EQ106.5b for tack and saddlery restrictions. GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.
- 2. EVENTING COMPETITIONS AT THE MODIFIED LEVEL OR ABOVE, COMBINED DRIVING COMPETITIONS AT THE ADVANCED LEVEL, DRESSAGE COMPETITIONS, ENDURANCE RIDES AND VAULTING COMPETITIONS: (SEE GR828.4 OF THE FEDERATION RULES). LIFE, SENIOR ACTIVE AND JUNIOR ACTIVE MEMBERS SHALL BE ELIGIBLE TO PAR-TICIPATE IN ALL CLASSES AT REGULAR COMPETITIONS. EVENTING COMPETITIONS AT THE MODIFIED LEVEL OR ABOVE AND COMBINED DRIVING COMPETITIONS AT THE ADVANCED LEVEL. DRESSAGE. REINING AND VAULTING COMPETITIONS AND ENDURANCE RIDES. A NON-MEMBER MAY PARTICIPATE AS A HANDLER, RIDER, DRIVER, OWNER, LESSEE, OR AGENT, AT REGULAR COMPETITIONS, EVENTING COMPETITIONS, DRESSAGE COMPETI-TIONS, REINING COMPETITIONS AND COMBINED DRIVING COMPETITIONS UPON PAYMENT OF A SHOW PASS FEE. PARTICIPANTS IN THE FOLLOWING CLASSES ARE EXEMPTED FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS RULE: 1) LEAD-LINE: 2) EXHIBITIONS: 3) GAMES AND RACES; 4) CLASSES FOR 4-H MEMBERS; 5) WALK TROT (EXCEPTION: FRIESIAN PERFORMANCE FR231) AND ACADEMY CLASSES (ACADEMY CLASSES ARE CLASSES LIMITED TO HORSES USED REGULARLY IN A LESSON PROGRAM); 6) USDF INTRODUCTORY LEVEL TESTS, PAS DE DEUX AND QUADRILLE CLASSES; 7) NRHA ENDORSED REINING COMPETITIONS. 8) OPPORTUNITY CLASSES, 9) CITIZENS OF OTHER NATIONS WHO HAVE PROOF. IN ENGLISH, OF CURRENT MEMBERSHIP IN GOOD STANDING OF THEIR OWN NATIONAL FEDERATION. 10) USEA BEGINNER NOVICE DIVISION: AND 11) ASSISTANT HANDLERS IN DRES-SAGE SPORT HORSE BREEDING CLASSES.

SAFE SPORT STATEMENT: Reminder: All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. More information about these can be found at www.usef.org.

3. Date of Entries: ENTRIES DUE: November 30. Post Entries will be accepted and all entries received at the horse show will receive a \$50 LATE FEE. It is recommended that entries be made online at www.horseshowsonline.com.

4. Acceptance of Entries: Once a horse is entered and accepted by the show it may not be withdrawn from competition without the permission of management. Exhibitors shall be held responsible for the stabling fee and service fee of all horse entered by them or their authorized agents(s) even though payment of these fees is not submitted with the entry form. In any case, horses that have not shown in classes on which they have been entered shall forfeit their fees except if a horse becomes ill or is injured prior to the start of the class or classes entered. The entry fee in this case will be dropped, upon receipt of a certificate signed by a licensed veterinarian and presented to the show secretary prior to the start of the class or classes entered. Once the show has started, only certificates signed by the Show Veterinarian will be accepted.

The Horse Show Management reserves to itself the right to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify any riders or exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of entries, and cancel award prizes, without claim for damages; to change any course, to cancel or combine any classes, or to reschedule classes after due notice to exhibitors; to change rings or rotate judges; use dotted line; and to change the specifications in jumper classes as competition warrants.

- **5.** CFHJA MEMBERSHIP: Points will be recorded for Hunter, Jumper and Equitation classes entered by CFHJA members who are permanent residents of the state of Florida and for horses/ponies that are permanently stabled in the state of Florida. Permanent resident/horse/pony CFHJA members of the state of Florida will be eligible for CFHJA year end awards. Points will start accruing the date membership payment and membership form is received.
- 6. Required Signatures on Entry Form: Entry forms will be accepted only when signed by every exhibitor, rider, coach, agent, and trainer. If the rider or owner is a minor, the signature of the parent, guardian or trainer must be provided. Upon failure to sign an entry blank as required, such person (s) shall be subject to an automatic fine of \$250. (GR 908) Entry forms must be accompanied by a check for stall fee. No acknowledgement will be mailed.
- 7. Spectator admission per person is \$3.00 (including .20 sales taxes). All exhibitors, their families, trainers and grooms are exempt. Please pay at the show office.
- **8.** STABLING: The cost per boarding stall or tack boarding stall is \$275.00 \$300 Main Barn \$300 Late \$325 after November 6th. Initial bedding will not be provided, and will be available through the fairgrounds. Move in date is Wednesday early arrivals will be charged \$35.00/day.
- 9. Prize Money: Prize money will be credited back towards each exhibitor's account. All refunds will be paid within 30 days off the close off the competition. IRS 1099 Miscellaneous Income Forms will be issued to the 1099 designee listed on the

entry form. REFUNDS UNDER \$20 WILL BE CREDITED TO YOUR NEXT SHOW BILL. Prize money will be paid within 30 days of the last day of the show.

- 10. Show Office Hours: The Show Office will be open beginning one hour before the start of each show day and will close after the last class. Exhibitor accounts will be processed and numbers given out in the show office on THURSDAY.
- 11. Back Numbers: Numbers will be issued only when entries have been paid or an open check has been left, and when all necessary signatures, addresses, Social Security Information for Prize Money, USEF measurement, amateur, and membership cards have been presented for all riders; trainers and owners on entry.

12. Memberships:

- a) Presentation of Federation Membership Cards: All owners, senior, junior, amateur, adult amateur riders and trainers are required to be competitin members. Junior and pony hunters must present the actual or a copy of their measurement cards at the Show Office before numbers may be picked up. All ponies and junior hunters that do not possess a current measurement card will be measured. Time and place of measurement stations will be announced.
- b) 1) Foreign Participants will now be required to join USEF as Competing Members. 2) Those individuals 18 years of age and older must take SafeSport Training to be eligible to participate in USEF national competitions. 3) For those participating in FEI events only, this requirement does not apply. 4) EC Sport Licence Holders Participating in USEF-National Competitions will now be required to join USEF as Competing Members at no cost.
- c) USHJA Eligibility to Compete
- 1. In order to compete in any Hunter/Jumping Seat Equitation classes at licensed competitions as an exhibitor, rider, trainer, or his/her agent(s), a person must be an Active member of the United States Hunter Jumper Association, Inc., or pay a Show Pass fee to the United States Hunter Jumper Association, Inc. Exception: Local Competitions and exceptions listed in GR901.9. Exception: Breed restricted Hunter/Jumping Seat Equitation classes.
- 2. USHJA Horse Registrations. a. All horses competing in Federation licensed and/or USHJA sanctioned competitions with Hunter, Hunter Breeding, Jumper and Hunter/Jumping Seat Equitation classes not restricted by breed must be properly identified in accordance with GR1101, and must also be registered with USHJA (See GR1101.1). The USEF/USHJA registration number for each horse must be entered on all entry forms for licensed competitions. b. Applications for USHJA Registration can be completed online at ushja.org or usef.org using the USEF Horse Registration application form. This form is also available from the USHJA or Federation office, as a download from the USHJA or Federation website or from competition management. Competition management is responsible for notifying exhibitors of this requirement in their prize list.
- 3.1 In addition to the provisions of EQ103.2, on or after December 1, 2017, all horses competing in classes that require USHJA horse registration must provide a microchip number that verifies their animal's identity in order to compete for points, money won or be eligible for Federation and/or USHJA programs and awards where horses are required to be recorded or registered.
- 3.2 A microchip used to verify identity must be a fifteen digit ISO compliant 11784/11785 chip and be implanted in the nuchal ligament of the animal.
- 4. As of Jan 1, 2019 every USEF adult member (18 years of age or older) with a Competing Membership must complete USEF's Safe Sport Training. Available in your membership dashboard online at USEF.org.
- 13. Management reserves the right to limit the Courtesy Circle in Hunter and Equitation classes.
- 14. Horses competing without a number or with an incorrect number may be refused an award at Management's discretion.
- 15. Horses will be allowed in the show rings only at such hours as are announced by Management.
- 16. The Open Numerical Hunter Scoring System will be used at the discretion of Management.
- 17. Orders of Go are produced in accordance with USEF Rules. Riders and trainers who have conflicts due to classes in more than one ring at the same time should see the Paddock Master so that necessary adjustments can be made. At no time will any ring be held up over 3 minutes due to conflicts.
- 18. All dogs must be leashed at all times while on the show grounds. Loose dogs will be picked up and detained until the owner has paid a \$100 fine. For a second offense, the owner may be barred from showing and required to leave the show grounds. We find this extreme action necessary in order to protect our exhibitors and their horses from injury.
- 19. Parking will be permitted in designated parking areas only. Vehicles may be brought to the stabling areas for only the purpose of loading and unloading and then must be promptly moved to the Van Parking Area. Your cooperation is appreciated.
- 20. All entries are required to have a stall per Florida State Fairgrounds and Fair Authority regulations.
- 21. In accordance with the 1989 Federal Waste Tracking Act, which restricts the disposal of medical waste, Bio Hazardous Medical Waste Containers will be provided in the stable area. All exhibitors and their agents are responsible for the proper disposal of the waste.
- 22. An office fee of 10% or \$25 (which ever is greater) will be charged on all returned checks.

- 23. All horses entering the state of Florida must possess an official interstate health certificate issued by a licensed veterinarian attesting to the fact that the animals are free from any symptom of infections or communicable disease. Current negative Coggins Test must be available upon demand.
- 24. ADDS/ SCRATCHES: All adds and scratches must be completed through the Show Office AND TAKEN TO THE RING BEFORE THE ADDED OR SCRATCHED CLASS BEGINS.
- 25. Anyone mounted must wear ASTM/SEI approved helmets while on the show grounds. . See GR 801.2 for further details.
- 26. Central Florida Hunter Jumper Association, Inc., The Bob Thomas Equestrian Center, their officials and employees will not be responsible for any accident or loss which may occur to any exhibitor, spectators, guest, rider, groom, attendant or other employee, animal or equipment at any of the shows.
- 27. Should any question arise that is not provided for in the rules, the same shall be referred to the show committee whose decision shall be final.
- 28. Trophies: In classes not offering prize money, trophies will be awarded in the show office.
- 29. By signing the entry form, exhibitors acknowledge and understand the following warning as provided in Florida Senate Bill 1658, Chapter 773, "Equine Zero Liability Stature": WARNING Under Florida law, an Equine Activity sponsor or equine professional is not liable for an injury to, or the death of, a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risk of equine activities."
- 30. Tack stall splits will be accepted when all entries are received and before 3pm on Friday. If tack stalls are not split they will be billed to a barn account. All shavings and feed orders are COD in the Fairgrounds office by 6 PM on Friday.
- 31. MOTORIZED VEHICLE USEF RULE Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

- 32. SCHOOLING RULES: WEDNESDAY SCHOOLING SCHEDULE, OPEN SCHOOLING FROM 12 NOON TO 4PM.
- 33, EXPRESS CHECK OUT = FILL OUT A SELF- ADDRESSED ENVELOPE AND WE WILL SEND YOU YOUR STATEMENT.
- **34.** Food concessions will be available during horse show hours.
- **35.** All horses competing in Federation non-breed restricted licensed competitions with hunter, hunter breeding, jumper and hunter seat equitation classes (except those activities enumerated in GR901.9, items 1-9) must be properly identified and must obtain a Registration Number from USHJA. A registration number for each horse must be entered on all entry forms for licensed competitions. Only one Registration Number will be issued per horse, and must remain with the horse throughout its career.
- 36. Equine Vaccination Rule GR845

At Federation licensed competitions, horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by Competition Management. Documentation should consist of one of the following methods mentioned below. The frequency of vaccine administration should be per the vaccine manufacturers' or veterinarian's recommendations. It is recommended that vaccines are administered by or under the direction of a veterinarian.

In the case of vaccines administered by a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide documentation from the veterinarian on documenting that the horse in question received the vaccinations; name of the vaccines and date of vaccine administration.

In the case of vaccines administered by a person other than a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide a receipt of the vaccine purchase which is signed by the owner, or agent with care, custody, and control of the horse; name, serial number and expiration date of the vaccine; and date of vaccine administration.

In the case of a horse that is unable to receive either of the vaccinations due to a history of adverse reactions, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide a letter from the veterinarian on official letterhead stating that the

horse in question cannot be vaccinated due to medical concerns and a log of temperatures taken twice daily for the seven days prior to entering the competition grounds. These horses must also have their temperature taken and logged twice daily while on the competition grounds. The log of temperatures should be provided to the Competition Management, stew-ard, or technical delegate when requested.

Competition Management may not amend or enhance vaccination requirements without prior approval of the Veterinary Committee.


